You Earned It - get The Credit

The Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) is a refundable federal income tax credit for low-income working individuals and families.

Workers who qualify for the EITC and file a federal tax return can get back some or all of the federal income tax that was taken out of their pay during the year. Even workers whose earnings are too small to owe income tax may qualify for the EITC.

You may be able to take the credit if:

- You have more than one qualifying child and your earned income was less than \$35,263 (\$37,263 if married filing jointly),
- You have one qualifying child and your earned income was less than \$31,030 (\$33,030 if married filing jointly), or
- You do not have a qualifying child and your earned income was less than \$11,750 (\$13,750 if married filing jointly).

Did you know that in Genesee County **MILLIONS** of dollars in tax refunds went unclaimed by thousands of families that didn't know they qualified for the EITC? Bring those dollars back into our community by spreading the word and volunteering.

The Genesee County Tax Assistance and Financial Literacy Coalition is a community-based partnership that assists families and individuals in reaching self-sufficiency.

The coalition provides income tax credit education and awareness, free tax preparation and asset building for the low-income community.



Volunteer Tax Preparation Program

These programs offer **FREE** tax preparation to working families making under \$37,263. Community volunteers receive training to help prepare basic tax returns. AARP tax aide and VITA sites are located throughout the community. **FREE** electronic filing is offered. To locate the nearest site in Genesee County, call 810-767-0500.

Items you need to bring to the sites to have your tax returns prepared.

- ❑ Photo identification
- ❑ Social Security Cards for you, your spouse, and dependents
- ❑ Birth dates for all people on the tax return
- ❑ Current year's tax package if you received one
- ❑ Wage and earning statements-Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, from all employers
- ❑ Interest and dividend statements from financial institution (Form 1099)
- ❑ A copy of last year's Federal and State returns if available
- ❑ Routing Numbers and Account Numbers for Direct Deposit
- ❑ Other relevant information about income and expenses
 - ~ Total amount paid for Child Care
 - ~ Child Care providers identifying #
- ❑ To file taxes electronically on a married filing joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign required forms.
